## Reporting Urgent Matters to the Police Dial 110 (hyaku touban)

If you are involved in an incident or accident, or if you see or hear anything requiring police attention, please call 110. Calls made to 110 in English are immediately connected to an English-speaking third party to enable a three-way conversation. You can make your call without having to worry about misunderstandings!

### For Fire or Ambulance dial 119

If you don't speak Japanese, just speak in English. Takasaki and Districts Joint Command and Control Center will connect your call immediately to an interpreter to enable a three-way conversation. Languages covered: English, Chinese, Korean, Portuguese and Spanish.

### **City Hall End of Year Hours**

Takasaki City Hall and branch offices will close for the end of year vacation at 5:15pm on Friday 27th December 2019, and open in the new year from 8:30am on Friday 3rd January 2020.

### **End of Year Waste Collection**

City waste will be collected by Takasaki as per the usual collection schedule up until Tuesday 31st December 2019. The service will resume in 2020 from Monday 6th January.
